### LED OUTDOOR LIGHTING SCHEDULE "LED-2"

### AVAILABILITY

Available for outdoor lighting to all members of the Cooperative subject to established Rules and Regulations for Electric Service.

### CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Outdoor lighting consisting of the installation of an outdoor lighting unit with an arm extension supporting an overhead lamp, diffuser and controlled by a photoelectric cell.

### MONTHLY RATE

(c) If more than one (1) additional pole is required, the Cooperative will provide each such pole or poles and related facilities for the sum of \$50.00 each. Such pole or poles and facilities shall remain the property of the Cooperative.

### HOURS OF LIGHTING

All lamps shall burn from approximately one-half hour after sunset until approximately one-half hour before sunrise every night and all night, burning approximately 4,000 hours per annum.

# OUTDOOR LIGHTING SCHEDULE "LED-2" (CONTINUED)

### KWH USAGE

Each 45-watt LED lamp consumes approximately 45 watts per hour. Therefore, a monthly consumption calculation of 15 kWh will be used for application of Schedule "PAC".

### TERM OF CONTRACT

The minimum term of any contract hereunder shall be for one (1) year from the date service is made available.

## OWNERSHIP OF FACILITIES

All facilities necessary for service, including fixtures, controls, poles transformers, secondaries, lamps and other appurtenances, shall be owned and maintained by the Cooperative. All service and necessary maintenance will be performed only during the regularly scheduled hours of the Cooperative. The Cooperative shall be allowed 48 hours after notification by the member to replace all burned-out lamps.

### WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

The amount of charges calculated at the above rate is subject the increase or decrease under provisions of the Cooperative's Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Clause, Schedule "PAC".
