AVAILABILITY

Available for outdoor lighting to all members of the Cooperative subject to established Terms and Conditions for Electric Service.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Outdoor lighting consisting of the installation of an outdoor lighting unit with an arm extension supporting an overhead lamp, diffuser and controlled by a photoelectric cell.

MONTHLY RATE

(a) 175 Watt, Existing Pole and Secondary	\$7.04	\$2.79
(b) 175 Watt, One Additional Pole	\$9.29	\$2.79
(c) If more than one (1) additional pole is required, the Cooperative will provide each such pole or poles and related facilities for the sum of \$50.00 each. Such pole or poles and facilities shall remain the property of the Cooperative.		

HOURS OF LIGHTING

All lamps shall burn from approximately one-half hour after sunset until approximately one-half hour before sunrise every night and all night, burning approximately 4,000 hours per annum.
